Killings and injuries^[1]

According to PCHR's documentation, Israeli occupying forces and settlers have killed **2828**^[2] Palestinians Civilians in the Occupied Palestinian Territories (OPT). To read the relevant Articles in international humanitarian law applying to [killings](#) and [assassinations](#), click on the blue words. Read the definition of [civilians](#) protected under the Fourth Geneva Convention here.

- **629** (22%) were children under age 17.
- **475**(14%) were killed in assassination operations, including at least **171** (37% of the total number of killed in assassinations) bystanders, of whom **44**(11%) were children.
- **274** (10%) were on-duty members of PNA security services.
- **18** were on-duty medical workers, including doctors and paramedics.
- **42** were killed by Israeli settlers residing in the OPT in violation of international humanitarian law.
- **8611** Palestinians have been injured since the outbreak of the Intifada in the Gaza strip.

^[1] From 29 September 2000 to 31 January 2005. Figures may change due to constant revision and updating of data. In addition, the unprecedented scale of Israeli attacks in the West Bank during April 2002 has made comprehensive data collection problematic.

^[2] This figure excludes Palestinians killed while participating in armed offensive attacks against Israeli targets.
